A few notes of interest about getting your CEUs:

Once an employee has entered the account number he/she must complete all other fields so that the certificate at the end of the evaluation can be printed or saved as a PDF with his/her personal information on it.

Expiration note: each bi-monthly test is available for accreditation for up to 12 months. This means that all staff have to the end of August 2016 to complete the testing and certification for the first issue. After that time period the accreditation is expired and cannot be completed.

There are a couple of milestones ahead for our OnCore clinical research management system. These include:



Integration

Integration will automate the flow of information between systems.

Integrating OnCore with other systems such as Cerner EMR and Horizon Labs will offer the following benefits: (1) Increase patient safety and (2) Enhance billing compliance (3) Increase the accuracy and consistency of data.

Research Resonance Network

Research Resonance Network is an online collaborative tool hosted by the vendor of OnCore that is:

Used to gather and compare performance metrics and benchmarking. A tool used to improve clinical research operations by contributing and comparing metrics to an anonymized aggregate of peer organizations.

The metric categories for the Research Resonance Network cover several areas in the study start-up process, including cycle times for IRB, Open to Accrual, and even newer Enrollment and Quality metrics, such as % Target Enrollment Met and SAE Reporting timelines.



As follow up to our EndNote class, now you can get hands on training on EndNote, the program now available to all BHSF in-network users. Discover how EndNote automatically indexes and formats in-text citations and reference page lists in a chosen style (APA, MLA, Chicago, etc.) and takes the tedium out of citing references for research, allows users direct connection searches on databases, and even functions as a personal database for citation records from different information sources.

- Reformat citation style with one click
- Search live within a personalized EndNote library
- Sort library by author, title or date
- Tag citations with personalized keywords, and more...
